Work groups are bringing stated tasks to completion. There are fewer and fewer tasks left to address. Most projects have gone according to plan. Some projects have brought new challenges, requiring extra efforts to correct. Here's the current status of the projects:

<u>Painting:</u> COMPLETED: Sanctuary, Narthex, Hallway, Heaven's Highway, Door Trim, Offices TO DO: Heat registers in Narthex and Hallway

<u>Welcome Desk:</u> Design established. Contractor hired. Desk is in process of being completed.

Design: Half an octagon shape with a Formica top on covered casters; Made of wood. Stained to match the dark wood in the narthex. Exploring the possibility of a carved logo or decorative ceramic tiles for the front

**Pews and Chairs:** COMPLETED: Recovering and installation of choir chairs and pews

**Carpeting:** COMPLETED

#### **Sanctuary Media:** In Process

It's been decided to purchase a long throw lens and place the projector on the back wall of the sanctuary, close to the sound board. The second projector would be placed on the opposite side facing the rear wall. The specs for the screen and box covering are being acquired; construction will begin in the coming weeks. 
