Holy Humor Sunday - April 11th

Holy Humor Sunday services not only give Christians an opportunity for ongoing celebrations of the greatest miracle in human history – Jesus' resurrection – it also gives each of us an opportunity to celebrate, and give thanks for, our own smaller resurrections in this world and this life. Please join us for the continued celebration of His resurrection through our Holy Humor Worship Service on Sunday, April 11 at 10:00 AM. This has become a beloved tradition and one that we missed out on in 2020. We have some fun Joy Breaks in store! Be a part of the fun and wear your colorful clothing in celebration.



The History:

Many American churches are resurrecting an old Easter custom begun by the Greeks in the early centuries of Christianity – "Holy Humor Sunday" celebrations of Jesus' resurrection on the Sunday after Easter. For centuries in Eastern Orthodox, Catholic and Protestant countries, the week following Easter Sunday, including "Bright Sunday" (the Sunday after Easter), was observed by the faithful as "days of joy and laughter" with parties and picnics to celebrate Jesus' resurrection. Churchgoers and pastors played practical jokes on each other, drenched each other with water, told jokes, sang, and danced.

The custom was rooted in the musings of early church theologians (like Augustine, Gregory of Nyssa, and John Chrysostom) that God played a practical joke on the devil by raising Jesus from the dead. "*Risus paschalis* – the Easter laugh," the early theologians called it.

In 1988 the Fellowship of Merry Christians began encouraging churches and prayer groups to resurrect Bright Sunday celebrations and call it "Holy Humor Sunday," with the theme: "Jesus is the LIFE of the party."

Spiritual Growth Streaming Services Update

Our team was granted an \$1,800 grant from the Presbytery of Lake Huron for the purposes of purchasing new and updated streaming equipment consisting of: a new camera and mounting bracket, new audio interface, new streaming software, streaming license and compatible laptop. We received another \$2,500 in private donations to help with the total expenses, which allows us to also install a new electrical outlet and purchase extra cables and additional items that may be needed. Even though we have been live streaming our services through FaceBook Live using an IPad, many have told us that it is hard to hear the audio. This new technology will allow us to continue to Live Stream our services well into the future, so that we can now reach our shut-ins, our snow birds and anyone out there looking to connect with a church service! And to do so in a well-connected fashion. Thank you Presbytery and to those private donors for making this possible!

Dear Church Pastors

As you well know, food and nutrition are closely linked with the ability to learn. Many families are able to receive support with food for their children through the free and/or reduced breakfasts and lunch program. However, weekends may present an extra challenge for families that are facing financial struggles. We want to help ensure that students have nutritious meals over the weekend, so they are ready to learn when they arrive at school on Monday.

In 2010, Holy Cross Lutheran Church, along with several other community churches in the Flushing area, started a program called *Bread for Life*. This program provides participating, eligible students with an opportunity to receive breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks in a bag for the weekend. This year the program is serving an all-time high of 115 children.

In past years, our costs were mostly covered by the annual *Wake the Bear* run and generous donations form area churches and their congregation members. Each September we have an amount that gets us through to the following run. Due to the extenuating circumstance of the Covid-19 virus, our 2020 *Wake the Bear* run had to be cancelled. We had money left from previous years to get us by until now. With the overwhelming need and the higher cost of food, our program is running out of funds; and with the funds that we have left, we may be unable to continue the program through the end of this year, and we will not have the funds needed to start the 2021-2022 school year. Our plan is to have the *Wake the Bear* run in September of this year.

I want to thank you and your congregation for your continued support. Your volunteers have truly helped this wonderful program. Unfortunately, I am asking for more. We are asking that you and your congregations pray for us, and if at all possible, to give a monetary donation to this important outreach of our community.


