RE-OPENING UPDATE

At the most recent Session meeting, much of the discussion surrounded the re-opening of our church. It gives us great pleasure to be able to share with you the following decisions that were made to take effect on June 1:

- Masks will be optional for in-person worship
- Social Distancing will be up to the individual
- Pews will remain spaced as they are now until further notice
- Singing without masks by all who wish to do so
- Attendance will be taken by an usher; names will not be taken for contact tracing purposes, but for attendance purposes.
- Friendship pads and prayer request slips will still be removed from pews until further notice.
- Communion and Offering will continue to be picked up and dropped off by individuals in the Narthex area.
- Our building will re-open to the members, public and all those who visit during office hours. Office is open Monday-Thursday, 9:00 AM 3:00 PM. The office is closed on Friday. Our security system in place means that our doors are still locked during these times.
- Windows will continue to be opened for ventilation purposes.
- Seating will be available in the Narthex, coat hangers will be placed for use.
- Bathroom usage will open to more than only one individual at a time.

We hope that this information brings great joy and excitement to all members and friends! Spiritual Growth has planned for July and August worship to take place outdoors to enjoy the beauty of the season; for inclement weather we will move inside. It is the hope and goal of your Session that all normal operations will be in place come September 2021. Thank you for your prayers, your patience and your support over this past year-long time of uncertainty.





Update from the Pastor Search Committee

The Pastor Search Committee (PNC) has been encouraged with the latest round of Pastoral candidates! We are currently speaking with four candidates that we are excited to pursue. One candidate is scheduled to visit and explore our area in hopes that they feel a sense of belonging. It will be a short weekend, but will conclude with a neutral pulpit. Please keep your PNC and this candidate in your prayers that this may lead to a mutually beneficial relationship and one that God has brought together! After two very encouraging interviews, another candidate has been asked to explore further with us and as of this writing we are still waiting to hear back from them. The other two candidates we are in the process of having second interviews and discerning our next move with each of them. We know we are all anxiously waiting for a pastor. It is easy to perhaps get discouraged, but know that we are working hard and even looking for new possibilities that may exist. Your PNC is NOT discouraged, but rather motivated to make sure that Flushing Presbyterian Church is the right fit for the right pastor in God's time.

Graduation Sunday - June 6


Join us on Sunday, June 6, as we celebrate the graduates in our congregation during our worship service. Let's all congratulate them on their achievements.

The genius of generosity

Kansas pastor Jack Wellman has been credited with the insight that "there is a certain genius in generosity." He explains that when we open our hands — figuratively speaking — to allow something to pass through our fingers, rather than holding it with tightly clenched fists, God can give us new blessings.

"God cannot pour more into hands that are already clinging tightly to what they hold," says Wellman.
