


Wednesday, March 5th at 7:00PM, a service of ashes will be conducted. As we begin the season of Lent, it is appropriate for us to gather as people of faith to remember, reflect, and prepare our hearts and minds for this 40 day journey.

Mark your calendar, bring your family, invite a friend, as we gather to begin this journey together.



For the six weeks of lent, a special study will be offered focusing on the "Final Words of Christ." Each gospel brings its own unique aspect of what Jesus said from the cross. The DVD series by Adam Hamilton will look at each phrase and put it into perspective with historical images as he helps us take a fresh look at some of these familiar phrases Christians recall during Jesus' crucifixion. Study begins Sunday, March 9, 6:00 - 7:00 PM, with each session ending with dessert.



On Sunday, March 9th, Pastor Teresa will begin a 6 week sermon series entitled: From Dark to Sight. This series is based on the Emmaus Road story (Luke 24:13-35). Two disciples traveling from Jerusalem to Emmaus on the evening of Easter Sunday are on a journey that began in despair at the death of their beloved friend and master. But by the time they reach Emmaus, their despair has been transformed to hope.

Join the journey to Emmaus as we explore our own "dark to sight" experiences.



During the last year, some of our members have been introduced to prayer stations. The feedback has been very positive. For Lent, we are expanding on this idea. You are invited to "Walk with Jesus through the Psalms" using prayer stations. Each week a new station will be set up until there are three (locations are being determined - look in the sanctuary). Meditations will then be rotated for the remaining weeks.

People of the congregation are asked to fill these segments so that at least one person is present in the sanctuary praying, reading and/or meditating during the hours Christ asked his disciples to stay awake and watch.

The segments begin at 8:00 PM on Thursday, April 17th, and end at 11:00 AM on Friday, April 18th. A signup sheet is on the bulletin board. You may take more than one segment. Prayerfully consider participating in this meaningful time of watching, waiting, and praying.




