Before Worship:

We are offering a Sunday School class before worship from 8:45 am to 9:45 AM titled *Trusting God*: A *Girlfriends in God Devotional*. This study is designed to deepen women's friendships as they share devotional experiences.

After Worship:

With *The Wired Word*, discussions will come to life as current events are related to Scripture passages. Lessons will be more pertinent to modern Christian living, and group dialogue will focus on how the verses covered each week apply to everyday life. This group is appropriate for ages Jr. High through adult.

The second class will again be a Ray Vander Laan series titled, *In the Dust of the Rabbi*. In Jesus day, disciples followed their Rabbi so closely that they would be covered with the dust kicked up by the Rabbi's feet. Come, discover how you can get dusty and be closer to your Rabbi, Jesus, by doing what he does. This group is appropriate for ages Jr. High through adult.

The third class is for our youth age preschool to 6th grade. They will be offered the study *Deep Blue*, where they will dive deeper into more of God's word.



As Christians our faith began with the followers of Jesus. But the beginning of our Christian faith as Presbyterians is in the Reformation. 500 hundred years ago, Martin Luther sparked the Reformation by posting his "95 Theses" on the door of the Castle Church in Wittenberg, Germany. The theology of the Reformers departed from the Roman Catholic Church primarily on the basis of three great principles:

- The Sole authority of Scripture This doctrine maintains that Scripture, as contained in the Bible, is the only authority for Christians in matters of faith, life and conduct.
- Saved by grace alone We are saved by grace alone, NOT by the good works that we do. "You are saved by God's grace because of your faith. This salvation is God's gift." Ephesians 2:8
- The Priesthood of all believers As believers, we ALL have direct access to God through Christ. There is no necessity for an earthly mediator. "There is one God and one mediator between God and humanity, the human Christ, Jesus" 1 Timothy 2:5

On Reformation Sunday, October 29th, we will celebrate the Reformation with a special worship service (including communion), by dedicating our commitments of our time, talent and treasure and with a special luncheon following the worship service. We will also be continuing our "Conversations Around the Table" during our fellowship time. Mark your calendar and plan on joining us on this special day!
