RETURN TO IN-DOOR WORSHIP! SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 6TH

You will be getting future communications about all of this information.

For those of you who might be uncomfortable entering the building, we will continue to offer the use of the transmitter so you can still sit in your car in the parking lot and listen to the service. There is a group working on offering live streaming of our services so we will pass along how to do this once that is up and running.

From the Interim Search Committee:

We have now finished the mission study and have passed it on to session to review. Once session approves it, it will go to Presbytery's Committee on Ministry (COM) for approval. Once COM approves, we will be given permission to form a Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) to search for a called (permanent) pastor. Normally, at this point our work would be done, but if the session would like us to continue to interview interim pastors as they may become available, we will. Getting an interim pastor at this point will not slow down the process of getting a called pastor at all, but rather just give us a pastor to do administrative work, pastoral care and provide a consistent minister on Sunday mornings.
