New Image, New Design Update

Work groups are diligently working toward our goal of having everything in place by Fall Start Up. It was a lofty goal, but one which seems achievable. We are on track. So here are some updates:

- <u>Painting:</u> Sanctuary, Narthex, Hallway, Heaven's Highway completed; Trim completed. To Do: Main Office + Heat registers in Narthex and Hallway.
- Welcome Desk: Design established. Contractor hired.

 Design: Half an octagon shape with a formica top on covered casters; Made of wood. Stained to match the dark wood in the narthex. Exploring the possibility of a carved logo or decorative ceramic tiles for the front
- <u>Pews and Chairs:</u> Chair backs and seats have been sent for recovering; chair wood frames are stored in a classroom; Pews will be removed Monday, July 20. Pew frames will be stored in Fellowship Hall.
- <u>Carpeting:</u> The new carpeting will be installed beginning Tuesday, July 21. Installation will begin in the sanctuary working back into the narthex, library and then the offices. Completion is scheduled for Friday, July 24.
- Sanctuary Media: The Media Work Group met with the contractor on Thursday, June 25. A few changes may be necessary, so following are tentative plans. Due to the size of the box for the screen, the location will be lower on the front wall to blend in with the piano. No complementary box will be needed. Exploring option to relocate projector so it does not distract the view when looking forward. The second projector for those leading worship will be in the back on the choir side. Laptop options are being explored.
- Narthex Furniture: Six chairs have been ordered for the narthex. We are waiting to hear an estimated date of arrival.


Tuesday, July 21 - Carpet Installation begins
